Mongolia is a pasture land supporting over 50 million herd animals. Mongolians see their horse is their best friend. **The Mongolian Nomadic Family** milks their mares five times a day, and the cows and yaks twice. The nomads of Mongolia sustain their lives directly from the products of domesticated animals such as cattle, horses, camels, yaks, sheep, and goats. Mongolian traditional cuisine primarily consists of dairy products, meat, and animal fats. The most common rural dish is cooked mutton, often without any other ingredients. Herders live in Mongolian traditional dwelling (covered felt) Ger.

What is a Ger?. This is a traditional tent of Mongolian nomads. Gers are round, with a hole in the center for ventilation. It is made of a wooden lattice covered with wool felt and can be taken down and moved quite easily. The word Ger literally translated from the Mongolian language simply means "home of Mongolia's nomadic families". The Ger is a symbol of Mongolia. Discovery Nomadic Lifestyle Tour gets you to the regions of Central Mongolia. Ride horses on the steppes, meeting nomadic people, staying in a traditional tent, seeing grasslands and beautiful vistas. Great opportunities for learn how to cook Mongolian traditional meals, the dairy products, play traditional games, and milk animals. Journey to Karakorum, the Genghis (Chinggis) Khan's 13th century capital and heart of the m ighty Mongolian Empire and Okhon river Valley, cradle of Mongolian civilization. Day 4-Ugii Lake-Tsenkher Hot Springs. (B)(L)(D)

**Day 5-**Tsenkher Hot Springs-Orkhon Waterfall. (B)(L)(D)


**Day 6-**Orkhon Waterfall-Elsen Tasarkhai Sand Dunes (Bayangobi Desert)-Bactrian Camel riding. **(B)(L)(D)** 

Day 7-Bayangobi Desert-Gorkhi/Terelj National Park. (B)(L)(D)

**Day 8-**The 40-meter (~133,3 feet) Statue of Genghis or Chinggis Khaan-Ulaanbaatar. **Tour Ends**. **(B)**

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Nomad Show (will take place from 10:00AM-12:00M). It demonstrates traditional living way of real Mongolian nomads and breeding and using of five kinds of livestock and movement from one place to another using ox, yak, camel and horse carts which are the carts. Here you will have the opportunity to hear a Mongolian folk song, to see 5 herding animals, to observe the demonstration of catching and milking sheep, goat, to observe the demonstration of making dairy products. Also, we will see the Mongolian archery, playing traditional games, the demonstration of making felt and tanning, the demonstration of moving one place to another use by cart, yak freight, camel and horse carts. Next, drive to visit Hustain Nuruu National Park of Wild Horses (hustai is Mongolian for birch and nuruu means mountains) measures about 57,000 hectares, or including the buffer zone 120.000 ha., and is located on about 120kms/75 miles west from the capital Ulaanbaatar. The flagship species for the Hustain Nuruu Nature Reserve is the reintroduced Przewalski horse. Overnight in tourist Gers Camp. (L)(D)

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**Day 2-**Breakfast. Trip towards west to **Karakorum-the Genghis (Chinggis) Khan's 13th century capital** and heart of the mighty Mongolian Empire and Okhon river Valley, cradle of Mongolian civilization. Visitors, such as **Marco Polo**, described its ornate building, including a 2500 sq. meters Palace of W orldly Peace. In 1792 the Monastery still had 62 temples and 10,000 lamas. But in 1930 it became a victim of the Stalin's purges. All but three of the Temples were destroyed and most of the monks were either killed or sent to Siberia. Overnight in tourist Gers Camp. **(B)(L)(D)** 








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Day 3-Breakfast. Visits Erdene zuu monastery, the Turtle monument and the Karakorum museum. A trip to reach Ugii Lake in the Orkhon Valley. Today, the cultural heritage of the valley constitutes a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Ugii lake-this a freshwater lake located in the valley of the Orkhon River is also renowned for its fishing. Optional activities such as fishing, boating, horseback riding, birdwatching, etc. (optional payment on site!). Overnight in Guest Ger. (B)(L)(D)





**Day 4-**Breakfast. Drive west to **Tsenkher Hot Springs**. **Relaxing and enjoy baths** at **Tsenkher Hot Springs** (89C/192.2F). **Visit a Yak breeder's family and experience the traditional customs and lifestyle of local residents.** Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)** 





**Day 5-**Breakfast. **Next, drive towards to Orkhon Waterfall (also called Ulaan Tsutgalan).** This is perfect for swimming, fishing, short trekking and walks around the surrounding area. On the way, **we visit Shankh monastery**-is one of the oldest and most important monasteries in Mongolia. **Zanabazar** founded this monastery in 1648 at the age of 13. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)** 

**Day 6-**Breakfast. Today, drive towards to **Elsen Tasarkhai (Bayangobi Desert)**, is a part of the 80kms/50 miles long Mongol Els Sand Dunes and is located on about 280kms/174miles west from the capital Ulaanbaatar. The nature in this area is really spectacular and great for relaxing. During the trip, you will also have opportunities **to visit a local nomadic family, ride two-humped Bactrian camel, walk on sand dunes, and relax in beautifully serene nature**. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. (B)(L)(D)



**Day 7-**Breakfast. A long drive north/eastern further to **Gorkhi/Terelj National Park.** The valley is about 20kms/12miles long at 1600m. This picturesque National Park is a part of Khan Khentii Strictly Protected Area. It is a great place for hiking, trekking, even you can rock climb here at its natural steep granite walls. **Explore on foot the Turtle shaped original giant rock. Hiking and walking to Arryabal Meditation temple,** on the top of mountain. During the trip, you will also have opportunities to **visit a local nomadic family**. Overnight in tourist Gers camp. **(B)(L)(D)** 

**Day 8-**Breakfast. Afterward, drive towards N/E to **visit the 40-meter (~133,3 feet) Statue of Genghis or Chinggis Khaan**. Visitors walk to the head of the horse through its chest and neck of the horse, where they can have a panoramic view. **Drive to Ulaanbaatar.** Transfer. **Tour Ends. (B)**

• At the time of registering for the trip, the amount of \$ US 600.00 (six hundred \$ US dollars + the bank discount of the intermediary banks) per person will be paid immediately by bank transfer as a deposit, with a minimum advance notice of **150** business days, before arrival in Mongolia.

• You must send us a photocopy of the original passport with a minimum validity of 6 months, in order to reserve and purchase domestic air tickets in Mongolia, hotels in Ulaanbaatar, and tickets to the Naadam Festival in the month of July.


• No registration will be considered valid until these requirements are formalized.

• The final payment of the trip will be made by bank transfer **95** business days before arrival in Mongolia, in order to guarantee the domestic air tickets (if any on the route) and all the indicated reservations.

**VERY IMPORTANT NOTE:** If you do not pay us on the indicated dates, we cannot guarantee the indicated services (\*so in this case, you need to check the new rates and if there is availability in other hotels).

CANCELLATION 180-91 days: \$ US 600.00 per person. 90-16 days: 50% 15-00 business days: 100%-NO REFUND.

**In the case of cancellations of air and train tickets:** it is another concept.
